PushCoin Cafeteria Point of Service (POS) System & Webstore

- Parents and students are adjusting to using the new POS system
- The webstore is open and allows parents to pay for clubs and sports as well as purchases replacement PE uniforms at MMS. We are beginning to explore the ability to include the bus transportation form for the activity buses
- The PushCoin system allows for billing parents for fees. The Millburn Before and After School Club is already using the system to bill parents. This can also be used for billing parents for field trips, Camp Timberlee, etc... As I understand it, if a child has a fee waiver, they will only be billed for the items that are not fee waived such as the iPad protection plan.

Standard & Poors Conference Call

- Dr. Lind and I participated in a conference call with Standard & Poors on August 22, 2019. Once they have a chance to review the items provided, they will make a determination regarding the District's credit rating.
- Once we receive that information, we will share it with the Board.

Summer 2020 Potential Projects

- I did a walk-through with the architects on Friday, August 16, 2019. They will compile a list with estimated costs for review in September. They would like for the Board to make a determination regarding Summer 2020 projects. This will allow them to assign the work in their office so that plans and specifications are ready for bid in late 2019 or in early 2020. This will allow us to get the best pricing.
- On Friday, September 6, 2019, I walked the parking and exterior areas of both buildings with the civil engineer and architect.
- The list at the end of this document contains some overlapping costs. For instance, if we remove and replace a parking lot, it won't need to be seal coated resulting in a reduced cost for crack filling, sealcoating & striping.

Budget Update

• I am still in the process of reviewing the budget and making adjustments on both the revenue and expenditure side.

Transportation Update

- We have received the GPS hardware that will allow us to locate our buses in real time. This hardware will work with the parent app that we purchased so that parents can receive estimated time of arrival for their child's bus. Once we have the app up and running, we will send information to parents with instructions on how to download and use the app.
- We did have a problem with a bus leak as a result of the installation of the GPS system for the bus cameras. I contacted the company and we had someone out to reseal the opening within a couple of days.
