INFORMATION/DISCUSSION

<u>FOUNDATION PRESENTATION</u> – Helmuth Fendel, vice president of the Millburn Education Foundation, announced that the Foundation is making a \$50,000 commitment to the district for next school year to support technology in the classroom. The Foundation sponsors two annual fundraisers: the March Madness Auction and a golf outing in the fall. Mr. Fendel said the Foundation has strengthened its financial position over the last several years and hopes to continue to make significant contributions to the schools.

<u>UPDATE ON MATH CURRICULUM</u> – Supt. Jason Lind updated the Board on progress made to implement the new math curriculum and align it with the Common Core State Standards. To illustrate the teachers' work, Supt. Lind distributed a copy of the 1st Grade Math Standards, the conversion of the standards into "I Can" statements, the Scope and Sequence of the Standards, and an Instruction and Assessment Schedule. This type of planning must be done in each grade level for reading and math. The Board discussed related topics, including:

- Rtl and other supports for students
- Number of days needed for testing
- Preparing eighth graders for high school classes
- Challenge of working with three public high schools
- Time needed to prepare for Common Core implementation
- Review and adjustments needed annually
